- 1) Payment in full must accompany this application
- 2) An application is a commitment to show. Notification prior to Tuesday, November 24, 2020 if you are unable to attend. Refunds will not be available
- 3) Parade Booths:
 - Set up begins at 7 AM, December 5, 2020, and must be completely set up before 9:00 a.m. Please secure your tents and display in the events of wind and rain. Booths may be on asphalt, therefore sand buckets, water weights, and/or tie straps would be helpful. .

The Booths are not to be broken down prior to the close of event at 2:00 p.m.

 - Electricity will not be provided
- 4) A Callahan Christmas:
 - Vendor Parking will be located in the front parking lot (left hand side when entering lot) on 1 Warrior Drive in front of the school
 - Front bus loop is available for un-loading (8:15 — 9:30 AM) and loading (1 — 2:45 PM)

- Doors for vendors will open at 8:15 AM and event will begin at 10:00 AM and end at 2:00 PM
 - You will need to provide your own table and chairs ● We will have flatbed carts (2) available to assist in set up ● Electricity is available with prior requests.
- 5) Exhibitors will provide own display set-up
 - 6) No pets allowed
 - 7) Personal items must be kept under tables. Display racks and tables shall be kept neat. Tablecloths/table skirts are encouraged
 - 8) To avoid a flea market atmosphere, we request that booth proprietors refrain from "mark-downs" sale items except for the final two hours of the fair
 - 9) Children must be supervised properly
 - 10) If you are uncertain of your booth location, do not begin set-up until you have spoken with the West Nassau High School staff or volunteers.
 - 11) Craft demonstrations are encouraged
 - 12) This is a family-oriented event, controversial items that could be interpreted as offensive will not be permitted. The West Nassau High School reserves the right to require that improper items be removed. Should this occur, the vendor will be pulled from the art fair and the entry fee will not be refunded, and the entry fee will not be permitted to enter next year's event. The West Nassau High School the right to refuse any application they deem not suitable for the venue. There is no appeal and their decision are final. No display of a sexual, immoral, or items of an offensive nature will be allowed
 - 1 3) Please remember, every exhibitor is responsible for a thorough clean-up of their area. Please dispose of all food and trash in dumpsters provided. Violators will not be able to participate next year. All tents, tables, and displays are to be removed.
 - 14) **IN THE EVENT OF EXTREMELY INCLEMENT WEATHER OR DISASTER OR EVENT WHERE THE SAFETY OF THE PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS OF THE CALLAHAN CHRISTMAS AND THE CHRISTMAS PARADE MAY BE AN ISSUE, THE WEST NASSAU HIGH SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THE FUNCTION AT ANY TIME**
