SALARIES AND COMPENSATION

GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 53-1. Town Council to set salaries; additional compensation for Clerk. [Amended 6-17-2002 by Ord. No. 3-O-2002; 10-1-2007 by Ord. No. 18-O-2007]

- A. The Town Council shall determine salaries for Town employees and elected officials by resolution or motion and vote from time to time as the Town Council sees fit.
- B. The Town Council shall have the power to authorize additional compensation for the Town Clerk at the rate of \$ 12 per hour for work authorized by the Town Council over and above the normal duties of the Town Clerk by a majority vote of the Town Council at a regular or special meeting.

§ 53-4. Procedure upon removal from office.

Any other provision herein notwithstanding, it is the express intent of the enacting body that should any Town official be removed from office for any reason, the compensation under this chapter to that official shall terminate at 12:00 midnight on the day that said official leaves or is removed from office, and that the compensation for the successor Town official shall begin at 12:01 a.m. on the next day so that the total compensation paid to any officeholder and any and all successor office holders during any month shall be exactly the amount set forth in § 53-1 of this chapter.

§ 53-5. Temporary increases or decreases authorized.

The governing body of the Town of Callahan, Florida shall have the power to increase or decrease the salary paid to any Town official on a temporary basis by enacting a resolution to that effect.
