ARTICLE I Storage and Disposal [Adopted 5-8-1948 as Ord. No. S-1]

§ 155-1. Storage and disposal of garbage. [Amended 8-19-2019 by Ord. No. 2019-O07]

Within the corporation limits of the Town of Callahan, Florida, all garbage, refuse, offal and filth shall be placed in and stored in a container supplied by the Town or its contractor until said garbage, refuse, offal or filth shall be removed by the Town or its contractor or disposed of by the owner or occupant of the premises in a manner not in violation of this article outside the corporate limits of said Town.

§ 155-2. Unlawful disposal.

It shall be unlawful for any person or owner or occupant of a premises to bury any garbage, refuse, offal, filth or cause to be buried, thrown or deposited any garbage, refuse, offal, filth or waste matter of any kind upon any street, road, sidewalk, lane or alley or right-of-way or upon the premises of another within said town limits of the Town of Callahan, Florida.

§ 155-3. Unlawful drainage.

It shall be unlawful for any person, owner or occupant of a premises to allow wastewater or waste matter from kitchen sinks, urinals or toilets to run or empty upon the ground, but said kitchen sinks or urinals or toilets shall be connected by a pipe with a proper septic tank for the reception of such wastewater and waste matter.

Residential garbage service shall be provided by the Town or through franchise agreements with private contractors on such terms as the Town shall determine or the contract shall provide.

§ 155-6. Container and refuse placement. [Amended 8-19-2019 by Ord. No. 2019-O07]

All persons receiving residential waste collection service shall place waste receptacles, disposable containers and other items at the curbside; provided, however, that for those who are physically unable to handle the containers, the Town may pick up the container at a convenient location upon customer request and Town agreement.

§ 155-7. Separation of recyclables; rates; containers. [Amended 11-7-2011 by Ord. No. 2011-O08; 8-19-2019 by Ord. No. 2019-O07]

- A. Each residential unit shall separate recyclables and place them in a separate container provided by the Town.
- B. The Town Council may set rates for garbage and recycling pickup by resolution or by entry into agreement with contractors to provide such services.
