The board discussed to possibility of future Micro Homes. Mr. Williams had been contacted by St. Johns County concerning these new homes. They discussed how the Town would handle the matter and the fact that there in not a minimum square foot in the Code book.

The board addressed the concern of the lumber business off of Green Ave., G & H Land and Timber Investments. The Town had received a complaint from a neighbor about the noise. The business is also not in compliance in how the property is zoned. It started as a pole barn, but is now enclosed. They have also added a lean-to and lumber. There are questions concerning the parking, weight issue of semi-trucks, and not a 10ft. clearance of street when semi-trucks are unloading.

The members continued the discussion of the 5 year plan.

Mr. Howard suggested a storm water collection/drainage area; street improvements; upgrading water system

Mr. Knagge suggested relocation of Town Hall; street improvements; installing a traffic light at US Hwy 301 and Mickler Street; a regional park

Mr. Bryan suggested more sidewalks; street improvements

Mr. Horne suggested de-snagging at Alligator Creek
