VI. Business

2nd Public Hearing for the Community Development Block Grant CBDG

Melissa Fox with Fox Enterprises 4425 US HWY 1 South Saint Augustine, Florida 32086. The purpose of tonight's public hearing is just to go over the proposed Block application that the Town is planning on submitting. Ms. Fox then provided hand outs to everyone in the room. The Town of Callahan plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a FFY 2022 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$650,000.00 in the Neighborhood Revitalization category. If not funded under the FFY 2022 application cycle, this notice and public hearing will be used for a subsequent FFY 2023 application cycle. For each activity that is proposed, at least 70% of the funds must benefit low — and moderate — income persons. The activities, dollar amounts and estimated percentage benefit to low-and-moderate -income persons for which the Town of Callahan is applying are: Sanitary Sewer System rehabilitation of 56 sanitary sewer manholes and rehabilitation of 600 LF of 8" gravity force main. The Town of Callahan anticipates it will take approximately Thirty (30) months for the Project to be complete including the environmental review, bidding, construction, and grant closeout.
