 - Mr. Kirk Closed regular meeting and opened the public meeting.
 - Mr. Rubright General Contractor representing SCW Liquors, here to answer any questions that you may have regarding this site plan for approval.
 - Mr. Bryan Am I seeing there is a pizza prep area and a food truck? Can you explain what the plans are
 - Mr. Rubright —The pizza prep area is inside the bar area on the east side adjacent to that is a roll up door on the north elevation, that will be a food truck backed up to there and you can come right to the door and make an order and receive your food. Probably 80% of all pizzas will be made inside the building in a kitchen prep area. The food truck is not part of the business it is a separate entity it will be one food truck at a time. There will be a rotation of different trucks but only one truck at a time.
 - Mr. Bryan Do you know the capacity for patrons?
 - Mr. Rubright Right now there are 55 seats in the bar area, 300 square foot per person in the liquor store for your parking space requirement.
 - Mr. Blue III The picture that we are looking at now is the final?
 - Mr. Rubright That is the final rendering/concept that Mr. Jones is going for.

- Mr. Bryan Is there any seating on the outdoor patio?
- Mr. Rubright It's more open for smokers. It is not a food service area.
- Mr. Kirk How many parking spaces do you have?
- Mr. Rubright We have a total of 41 spaces and 2 handicap.
- Mr. Schwend It says stage platform is that in the new addition?
- Mr. Rubright Yes it is for small local bands.
- Mrs. Piipke Another thing I wanted to bring up is drainage. We don't see anywhere on here where you're proposing a retention pond.
- Mr. Rubright There is a big area behind it already.
- Mr. Williams But there is no pond, and you are creating a large impervious area. You will need to get a letter from the St. Johns River Management saying they don't require a retention pond, or he is going to have add a pond to the drawing.
- Mrs. Gugliuzza Sir will the patio area be open?
- Mr. Rubright Not to the public you can only come in to the patio area from the bar. You can't leave the outside patio area unless you come back into the bar and exit the building it will be fenced in by some wall mechanism. People will not be able to come in through the patio and patrons will not be able to exit the patio without coming through the entrance or exit of the bar.
- Mr. Williams You will need to address the drawing showing how the patio area will be enclosed and you won't be able to go to the Council until we get the letter from SJWM.
- Mr. Kirk I will now close the public hearing and open the regular meeting.
 - Motion to approve Site Plan Review of the SCW Liquors with the contingency that you get a letter from SJWM stating that they don't need a Retention Pond and an architecture drawing showing the enclosure of the patio area- <u>Mr. Bryan</u>
 - Second the motion <u>Mr. Blue III</u>.
