ORDINANCE NO.: 2018-002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CALLAHAN TO REPEAL CODE § 162-4 PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS TO THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAX; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Callahan finds that repealing its exemptions to the municipal service tax will benefit safety, health, and the general welfare of the Town of Callahan because state law mandates such exemptions at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CALLAHAN, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 162-4 of the Code of the Town of Callahan, Florida is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereto.

Section 3. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
