


Ordinance 2018-003 to amend the Alcohol Beverage Section of the Town Code was removed per Mr. Branham & Mr. Williams.

Would like to change section 66-27 in the Alcoholic Beverage.

Measurement of distance. Last amended 7-21-2008 by ordinance # 2008-11

Currently reads:

The distances provided for by this article concerning the location or proposed location of a business licensed to sell alcoholic beverages shall be measured by following the shortest route of ordinary pedestrian travel along public thoroughfares from the main entrance of the proposed or existing licensee to the main entrance of the other licensee, church, or day-care center or in the case of schools or public parks, to the nearest point of real property used for a school or public park.

Change to read:

The distance provided for by this article concerning the location or proposed location of a business licensed to sell alcoholic beverages shall be measured from the nearest property line of the existing or proposed licensee to the nearest property line of the other licensee, as determined by using an aerial line measurement. The Town will use the Nassau County Property Appraisers GIS mapping tool to determine distance.
