 - Ms. Murdock is working on condemned homes, retention ponds, and cleaning up properties.
 - Distance marker in front of Burger King has been down. Mike said that the marker would be put back once utility work is completed.
 - Traffic study of Mickler and US 301 intersection was completed before the end of the school year and now we await those results.
 - Asked whether advance signage can be placed when roads are going to be closed. Mike said that notification should have been placed on the Amhurst Oaks community board.
 - The DOT right of way adjacent to the ice house at Green and US 1 needs to be cleaned up.

 - o A new Water and Sewer secretary, Shawna, has been hired.
 - Attended a second meeting with the School Board. Working on the draft of the agreement.
 - Received feedback from some residents that a take one leave one library at the park would be a nice addition.
 - Traffic signal at US 1 and 5th Ave needs working on timing. Mike said new system is changing the lights where it detects traffic on either side.
