TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STATE ROAD FOR THE ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARADE; AND FINDING A
PUBLIC PURPOSE**

WHEREAS the Callahan Town Council may by resolution authorize a Temporary closing of the roads for the Annual Christmas Parade serves a public purpose by promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town;

WHEREAS the Town of Callahan desires to authorize temporary closing of roads for the annual Christmas Parade with stationed detour routes;

WHEREAS the Callahan Town Council makes a specific finding that by temporary closing of roads for the annual Christmas Parade with stationed detour routes will serve a public purpose in promoting the general welfare of Callahan;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CALLAHAN, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to § C-18 of the Charter of The Town of Callahan, Roads, and Streets; The Town of Callahan shall have full and complete jurisdiction, charge, and control over all public or dedicated roads.

SECTION 2. This Resolution will become effective upon adoption.




