- Lease Agreement Nassau County School Board
 - Discussion:
 - Mr. Williams recommended turning the property which is the student parking lot and part of the Gymnasium over to the School Board.

 - Council Consensus: Hold off on final decision until the Attorney's work out the legal aspects.

 - Mr. Fontes recommended only a 5% increase on the Sewer side, and a 3% on the Water side.

 - Clerk to Run Ad in Newspaper for Public Hearing, and start Ordinance Procedures.
