February 5, 2018 7:00 P.M.

- Mayoral Proclamations
 - o Ms. Ophelia Morgan Judson 104th Birthday
 - Mayor Rau read and presented the Proclamation to Ms. Morgan's son and Deacon Blu.
 - Mr. Morgan thanked the Town for honoring his Mother, and asked everyone to keep her in their prayers, and to feel free to visit or call her.
- West Nassau Historical Society John Hendricks Railroad Days
 - o Mr. Hendrix updated the Council on what the WNHS has done this past year.
 - Asked the Council to consider sponsoring the Children's area of the Railroad Days again this year.
 - Mr. Bass said it will be on the Agenda for the next meeting for consideration.
 - o The Railroad Days will be on April 21st. There will not be a parade this year.
- Relay 4 Life Wanda Nichols
 - Mrs. Nichols stated she took over the Relay this year to hopefully get the Town excited about it again.
 - She stated she saw first-hand where the funds go when she was diagnosed with Leukemia and had to stay at the Hope House in Gainesville.
 - o The Relay will be on April 6th & 7th this year at the Fairgrounds.
 - She asked the Council to consider having a team and sponsoring with a \$500 donation.
 - o Mr. Bass stated it will be on the Agenda next meeting for consideration.
 - Mrs. Graham stated that Mrs. Nichols has done a great job and is really working hard.

VIII. Business

- CDBG Bids & Award of Contract
 - Mr. Tim Norman of Mittauer & Associates stated there was a Bid opening for on the 31st of January for the Construction Contract on the Waterlines.
 - He stated the Town received 10 Bids ranging from \$642,145.50 up to over 1 million.
 - He stated even the lowest Bid is still \$56,145.50 over Budget, and the Town would need to put that money up.
 - He recommended the Town Award the Bid to Worth Construction Company who has done good work for them in the past.
- Motion to <u>Award the Contract to Worth Construction Company in the Amount of</u> \$642,145.50, and for the Town to cover the \$56,145.50 Shortfall by <u>Mr. Fontes</u> and 2nd by <u>Mr. Mellecker.</u>

- o Discussion:
 - Mr. Fontes we really need to cover the shortfall, so we don't lose the whole Grant.
 - Mayor I feel this really needs to be covered, so we can move forward on this.

- Clerk/Deputy Clerk
 - Mrs. Knagge presented salaries of like size Municipalities, and a list of Elected Clerks with and without Deputy Clerks.
 - Mr. Fontes stated maybe we could just look into cross training the Office staff more, and if the need arises to Train a new Clerk we can hire a seasoned Clerk to come handle the Training.
 - Mrs. Shaw asked how many hours do I think a Deputy Clerk would need to work, and how many hours does it take Mrs. Knagge to do what needs to be done. Mrs. Knagge stated it varies throughout the year according to what needs done according to the Laws.
 - o The Mayor & Mrs. Knagge will work together to cross train the office staff, so they can help the Town to continue to move forward.
